The Governor came to thank the work done in the production of the drapes for the region

Martin Půta met today with Rector Miroslav Brzezina to express his gratitude to the university for the drapes that the teams of our three faculties have been supplying to the region for several days.

Then, accompanied by the Rector and Vice-Rector Aleš Kocourek, he also visited the places where the drapes are made. Both the new equipment of the Department of Textile and Single Purpose Machines of the Faculty of Engineering, which produces the initial nano-material, and the equipment of the Department of Nonwovens and Nanofibrous Materials of the Faculty of Textiles, which produces the matrix from a mixture of nano- and microfibres. One of the stops was an impromptu sewing workshop, into which the meeting room of the Institute for Nanomaterials, Advanced Technologies and Innovation was transformed just a few days ago.

At these and other workplaces of our university, teams of the above-mentioned faculties work together with people from the Department of Chemistry of the Faculty of Science and Humanities and the Faculty of Education on the drapes for the Liberec Region. In addition to about 3,000 finished drapes, we have so far supplied 10 kilometres of material to the sewing companies contracted by the region, which will make about 18,000 drapes.

Hejtman Martin Půta appreciated both the work of our people and the promptness with which our scientific teams responded to the lack of protective equipment in the country.
