Article 1 General Provisions

- (1) Purpose of this Directive is to lay down all the rules for awarding scholarships to Ph.D. students at the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering of Technical University in Liberec.
- (2) The scholarship is granted in accordance with §91 of Act No. 111/1998 Coll. (University Education Law) and Scholarship Order of Faculty of Mechanical Engineering of Technical University in Liberec (hereinafter referred to as "Scholarship Order").

Article 2 Concept Definitions

Basic Scholarship – paid out monthly for the standard period of studies
Scholarship for publication activities – for outstanding publishing results, paid out for 6 months
Scholarship for supporting studies abroad – one-off exceptional scholarship
Scholarship for outstanding study results and professional activities – one-off exceptional scholarship
Scholarship for fee-paying students for doing one 's study duties who are studying in a foreign language – exceptional scholarship paid out monthly.

Article 3 Basic Scholarship¹

- (1) May be awarded to students of Ph.D. Study Program in full-time attendance in the sum of 11 500,-CZK for a month.
- (2) A full scholarship is provided to students of study programs lectured in the Czech language who fulfill tasks and duties in accordance with a study plan condition-control regarding the overall correct performance. In case of non-compliance, reduction of the scholarship is regulated by Scholarship Order.
- (3) Scholarship is paid out during the standard period of a study (12 months a year).

Article 4 Scholarship for a Publication Activity and Documentation for Results Evaluation and Scholarship Approval

- (1) Scholarship² for a publication activity may be awarded for outstanding results when fulfilling the following conditions:
 - (a) The total period of Ph.D. studies are not longer than 60 months,
 - (b) Student fulfills tasks and study duties in accordance with the individual study plan, or more precisely with the annual study plan,
 - (c) Student is an author or co-author of significant results and gains points for outstanding results from his/her professional work for publication in decisive periods of a calendar year³.
- (2) Only the students who have been led as a home-creator of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering within the framework of the data transfer into IS R&D can be included in the evaluated results.
- (3) Evaluation of results (points counted):
 - (a) Article in a Journal with a non-zero impact

(b) Article in a journal listed in WoS or Scopus⁴ database

(c) Article in a conference proceedings listed in WoS or Scopus⁵

(d) Other publications in a world language

(e) Other publications in other languages

- (4) Materials for evaluating results and granting scholarship:
 - (a) The list of publications with photocopies of contributions for the relevant period must be submitted by the student to the Dean's Office by 30th June and 31st December of a particular calendar year (only the publications issued in the relevant period can be counted, the published abstracts are not counted, the impact factor and the classification into databases necessary to be documented.)
 - (b) The list must contain full bibliographic citations of individual publications, and the student's share of the result must be reported (in%), the share of the supervisor in the publication is added to the Ph.D. student's share.
 - (c) The list must be signed by a student and his/her supervisor who are responsible for the correctness of the data.
 - (d) For evaluated articles according to paragraphs d) and e), mentioned in conference proceedings, the student will provide confirmation of the personal attendance.
 - (e) The amount of a scholarship is determined by the number of earned points. Each point is rated 500 CZK. In the case of co-authorship, the student's aliquot point score is included in the result. For other publications (publication type d, e) a student can obtain a maximum of 3 points during the decisive period.
 - (f) During the decisive period, a scholarship can be awarded to the student for publishing activities up to 10.000 CZK per month. The amount of the scholarship is set for a payout for 6 months.
 - (g) The scholarship is paid out monthly, at the same time as the basic scholarship.

Article 5 Scholarship⁶ supporting studies abroad

(1) The Dean may grant a student a one-off extraordinary scholarship to support his/her studies abroad if the student fulfills tasks and responsibilities in accordance with the curriculum. The details are regulated by the Dean's Directive No. 3/2015 regarding support of a student during his/her studies (working) abroad.

Article 6 Scholarship⁷ for outstanding results in studies and a professional activity

(1) The Dean may award a one-time extraordinary scholarship for extraordinarily excellent results in a study or in a professional activity (patent, prize-awarded conference paper, commercialized result, etc.) or an exceptionally successful dissertation.

Article 7

Scholarship for fee-paying Ph.D. students for doing one's study duties who are studying in a foreign language

(1) Scholarship may be awarded to fee-paying, full-time doctoral students who are studying in a foreign language up to 1.200 CZK a month.

⁶ The scholarship may be awarded in accordance with Section 91 (4) of Act No. 111/1998 Coll. (University Education Act) to support study abroad.

⁷ The scholarship may be awarded in accordance with Section 91 (2) of Act No. 111/1998 Coll. (University Education Act) for excellent results and special extraordinary cases.



- (2) Scholarship is provided to students on the basis of their application, who perform tasks and duties in accordance with the curriculum. There must be given a consent of the supervisor in the application.
- (3) The scholarship is paid monthly for the standard period of study (12 months per year) but not earlier than 6 months after enrollment.

Article 8 Transitional and final provisions

- (1) The Vice-Dean of the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering for Science, Research and Doctoral Studies is authorized to review and evaluate compliance with the Directive.
- (2) This Directive abolishes Directive No. 2/2015 concerning the award of scholarships to students of Ph.D. study programs.
